OUR AIM

Powerhouse College provides growing Christians with an opportunity for in-depth Biblebased study. Our aim is to help our students deepen their relationship with the Lord and to make them firm and stable in the work of His kingdom. We endeavour to provide an indepth understanding of the Word of God and not to promote or emphasise the teachings of men.

These courses are a tremendous resource of rich, practical knowledge and wisdom, based on God's Word, and are an effective aid to spiritual development and suitable for all believers.

COURSES

The courses are modular based. This means that students can begin their studies at any time during the year.

MINIMUM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

There are no minimum qualification prerequisites for the Certificate of Ministry.

For example, a student who has passed only grade eight (8) may enrol for the Certificate programme. Once they have completed the Certificate in Ministry successfully, they will be accepted into the Diploma. The Diploma allows entrance into the Bachelor Degrees, and so on.

MINIMUM AGE

No student may begin with their studies unless they have attained the age of 16 years before enrolling.

STUDENT NUMBER

Each student is allocated a student number. Please quote this number at all times when corresponding with our office.

We do not prepare our students for secular work or denominational service. We will seek to provide a sound theological standing from which our students may fulfill their divine purpose and calling.

GRADUATION

A graduation ceremony is held at the end of each year where Certificates, Diplomas and Degrees are conferred. Students who wish to graduate, should complete all exams (100%)by the mid-October, of that particular year. Please note that students are only capped at the ceremony, and certificates will be printed the beginning of the following year, and <u>only received by May as it is printed in the USA.</u>

Students are required to pay a graduation fee of \$500 *per qualification*. The fees are payable whether the student attends the graduation ceremony or not. Gowns and caps are provided at the ceremony.

ACCREDITATION

The World-Wide Accreditation Commission of Christian Educational Institutions (WWAC) accredited the university. WWAC is a non-governmental accreditation, extended exclusively to private Christian institutions upon inspection and approval of their programmes, operations, and integrity. Team Impact Christian University is fully accredited by WWAC and their coursework therefore implemented at Powerhouse College.

Please adhere to the following requirements:

- 1. The student name and number must appear on all correspondence and the cover page of all coursework submitted preferable on each page submitted.
- 2. Exams are found in the back of their books. Students must adhere to all the requirements as detailed in the examination paper.
- 3. Students are not to make commentaries or personal doctrinal notes on the work submitted. Marks will be deducted for this.
- 4. If the answer cannot be found in the book, it is assumed the student has done additional reading in the Bible as well as sourcing other materials. It must be pointed out that this is more the exception than the rule and will occur very seldom.
- 5. Grading is also based on presentation of work.
- 6. Students are required to keep a copy of all their work submitted. We are not responsible for work lost in the post. If in doubt, please send all post by registered mail and email.
- 7. We are not able to return student assignments.
- 8. Bachelor results can take more than 8 weeks before receipt thereof
- Completed work may be posted to our office or emailed to <u>dean@powerhousecollege.com.au</u> only, in either PDF or WORD format. *Students* are requested to make use of the "EXAM ANSWER SHEET", and not answer on the exam itself.
- 10. Students must complete each level of study (eg: Certificate of Ministry) within three years.
- 11. Students are allowed to work as a group <u>but</u> each student must submit their own work for grading. Any work which is identical to the work of another student will be returned.
